CROATIAN STUDIES

Macquarie University in Sydney is a national provider of Croatian Studies in Australia. The program offering Croatian language, culture, history, literature and migration studies began in 1983 and has been growing from strength to strength in the last three-and-a-half decades.

PLEASE NOTE THAT CROATIAN CAN BE STUDIED FROM ANYWHERE IN AUSTRALIA. ALL CROATIAN UNITS CAN BE STUDIED IN EXTERNAL MODE, SUPPORTED BY ONLINE LEARNING AND TEACHING FACILITIES. YOU CAN CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) – MAJOR IN CROATIAN

Students have an option of either majoring in Croatian or taking individual units. Croatian units may be taken as part of a number of different degrees and awards.

DIPLOMA IN LANGUAGES (CROATIAN)

Three-year part-time program. Diploma is open to anyone who qualifies for admission to a degree. It can be completed together with a degree or as a stand-alone program.

CROSS-INSTITUTIONAL STUDY

Cross-institutional study is for students currently admitted to an undergraduate or postgraduate award at an Australian higher education provider, and who wish to undertake Macquarie Croatian

units which will count towards that particular award at their home institution within Australia.

THE NON-AWARD PROGRAM

Non-award program allows students to enrol into individual units without the restriction of a degree. The program is suitable for students looking at studying for general interest or for professional development.

NOTE: Students enrolled in a BA or Diploma have the opportunity to study in Croatia for a short period of time (Summer School of Croatian Language and Culture in July, University of Split), or for one whole semester (University of Zagreb).
